The laser illuminators have a 600-foot visible range in ultra-low Lux applications, whereas IRs typically max out around 240 feet. The Thermal Titan, to be released this fall, allows users to observe subjects from significantly further away in low-Lux applications, far surpassing even the Titan Laser. The WiFi Titan, also available to customers this fall, takes the adaptability of the Titan line further still with the capability to observe and record wirelessly.
